CURRICULUM

D.D.P.S. follows C.B.S.E. Curriculum.

ADMISSION

- ◆ Admission to the school will only be confirmed after receiving an official written notice from the school. No interview is required for admission in playgroup.
- ◆ At the time of admission, the following certificates should be attached with the application form:
 - Birth certificate (once admitted, no change of date of birth will be entertained)
 - Original transfer certificate from the school last attended .(to be submitted within 15 days after the commencement of the academic session)
 - Admission is formally completed only when the form has been filled and submitted to the office and school dues are paid.

WITHDRAWALS

Application for transfer certificate must be given in the prescribed form by the parents

- ◆ A clear month's notice of withdrawal must be given to the administration in writing on or before the 7th working day of the month.
- ◆ All dues must be cleared before the transfer certificate is issued.

FEE RULES

- ◆ Parents must ensure that all the school fee dues are paid on time. Fee should be paid between the 1st -10th of the month.
- ◆ A ₹20 late fee fine per day is applicable in case school fee is not paid by the 10th of each month. In case of a genuine problem, an application regarding it may be considered.
- ◆ The fee is subject to a 10% increase each year.
- ◆ A student whose fee and other school dues are not cleared will not be allowed to sit for the half yearly /final examination.
- ◆ The school acknowledges every payment made to it by duly signed receipt .Parents are requested to make sure that they receive a proper receipt for every payment they make.

LEAVE RULES

- ◆ If a student is absent on the first or the last day of the term or for **seven consecutive days without permission**, his/her name may be struck off from the register and will be readmitted only on the payment of the usual admission fee.
- ◆ A prior permission for leave from the principal should be obtained, except in cases of unforeseen circumstances.
- ◆ A child with an infectious disease or one who has shown any symptoms such as cough, running nose, fever or rash should rest at home and not be sent to school and report to school immediately.
